27. UPDATE: from the Living Brue Working Group

Lindsay presented a summary of the Living Brue Day to be held in the Main Hall and atrium on Saturday March 28th. A range of speakers, stalls and activities celebrating the River Brue and raising awareness about river pollution causes and potential solutions. The working group are requesting funds to pay for room hire, marketing, printing and other running costs. It seems that GTC has voted to wave room hire for projects run by their committees, and Melissa will check this.

That CEEAC will provide funds to the Living Brue Day, up to £500 if the rooms are provided by GTC, or up to £700 including room hire.
