161. TO RECEIVE A PRESENTATION FROM REPRESENTATIVES OF AVON AND SOMERSET POLICE ON THE SUBJECT OF ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR IN GLASTONBURY AND HOLD DISCUSSIONS ABOUT THE FORCE'S FUTURE PLAS FOR THE TOPIC

Members received a comprehensive presentation from Inspector Matthew Reed on the above topic and the Police's plans to tackle Anti-Social Behaviour and crime in Glastonbury. The inspector's colleagues Sergeant Lancey and Superintendent Turner were also present.

Members gave feedback to the Police representatives and thanked them for their presentation. Members reflected that they were left reassured by the police's work and plans for the next three-years.

Members of the public were also invited by the Mayor to make comment and ask questions. Members of the public were urged to pass on their concerns and any information on this topic or any crime to the Police. The public were similarly reassured and thanked the Local Beat Team for their work in the Town.

During the presentation, Inspector Reed raised that it was his wish to establish a working group of The Police, Town Council, local business, and groups to discuss the tackling of Town Centre Crime. This suggestion was proposed by Cllr Cousins. This was seconded by Cllr Cottle and **RESOLVED** unanimously.

The Town Clerk is to work with the Police and Town Council members to establish this group.
