Members discussed various highways works that needed to be completed in Glastonbury on a variety of grounds. The discussion culminated in a prioritised list of works as below:

Urgent	Magdalene Street	Reinstate the paved inserts to the roadway as they are uneven for pedestrians and vehicles, causing noise, vibration and damage to vehicles and property	Safety, Amenity, and Damage to Property
	St John's Car Park	Instate resident's parking permits for those who live in the immediate area	Amenity
	Oriel Drive	Add Double Yellow Lines from the junction with Street Road until the entrance to Tor Leisure to prevent roadside parking which restricts visibility	Safety
	A361	Remove the A361 from the national freight route as it causes dangerous levels of traffic along the route which causes damage to property	Safety, Amenity, and Damage to Property

	Street Road, Magdalene Street, High Street and Bere lane	Re-marking Zebra Crossings and adding additional lighting so that pedestrians can be seen wishing to cross the road	Safety and Active Travel
	Magdalene Street/A361 and Dyehouse Lane/Porchestall Drove	Re-marking the mini-roundabouts so they can be seen by drivers and adhered to	Safety
	Rush Hill, Farrington Gurney	Change the wording on the road sign to reduce traffic directed through Shepton Mallet for Glastonbury. Adding Glastonbury and "Unsuitable for Heavy Goods Vehicles" to the direction for Wells	Safety, Amenity and Damage to Property on the A361
	Street Road	Add a pedestrian crossing at the base of Wearyall Hill near Tor Leisure so pedestrians can cross to and from Wearyall Hill and cross before the pavement disappears toward the A39 Roundabout	Safety, Amenity, and active Travel
	Old Wells Road	Resurfacing of the entire road	Safety and Amenity
	Glastonbury Parish	Road signage review – update signs and remove unnecessary signs	Safety, Amenity, and Tourism
	Gipsy Lane	Improvement of drainage to prevent standing water on the road that freezes	Safety
Important	Paradise Estate	Double Yellow Lines to be added to the entrance to and exit from the estate to increase visibility	Safety
	Benedict Street	Resident's Parking Permits in Benedict Street	Amenity
	Windmill Hill Estate	20 mph limit for the whole of Windmill Hill estate	Safety
	Glastonbury Parish	20 mph limit for the whole of Glastonbury	Safety
	Bere Lane / Fisher's Hill	Mini Roundabout on the junction of A361, Fisher's Hill, Butleigh Road and Hill Head to improve the junction	Safety
	Cinnamon Lane at the Junction with Chilkwell Street	Double Yellow Lines at the junction to prevent parking and allow vehicles to exit and enter Cinnamon lane safely	Safety
	Tor View Avenue junction with The Roman Way	Double Yellow Lines on Tor View Avenue, south of the end of The Roman Way to prevent parking and increase visibility	Safety
Desirable	Archer's Way, Northload Street and Wells Road	Cycle paths in line with the recommendations in the Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan undertaken by Mendip District Council	Amenity and Active Travel

	Benedict Street and Garvins Road	Alter the layout of the junction to give right of way to traffic travelling along Benedict Street	Safety
	Garvins Road	Double Yellow Lines opposite the entrance to Bella View Gardens and at the junction with Sedgemoor Way	Safety
	High Street	Improve the surface of pavements and make them level to stop people tripping over and improve access for those less mobile	Safety and Amenity
	Manor House Road junction with Wells Road	Extend Double Yellow Lines at this junction looking South to improve visibility	Safety
	Cottle Close	See that the dropped kerb is installed as planned	Amenity
