

March – Police report to Glastonbury Town Council

- 5 x persons have been arrested in the Glastonbury area for separate warrants issued for them failing to attend court.
- The Neighbourhood team were supported by local response officers in attending a travellers site in Glastonbury after a report of a male with a weapon. The weapon was located and seized. On the conclusion of the investigation the weapon will be destroyed.
- PC 4151 MILLER has seized a vehicle for having no tax on Beckery road, Glastonbury. The owner of a second vehicle has been given a warning.
- The neighbourhood team have assisted Operations units who were called to a caravan site in Glastonbury reference a violent incident. A male was arrested and two weapons were seized for destruction.
- PCSO 7554 Lindsell has issued a male with a Community Protection Warning as a result of continuing to cause Anti-social behaviour.
- PCSO Mel ROWLANDS received a complaint about an aggressive beggar. She attended and issued the male with a 1st warning and moved him out of the area.
- PC 2169 Moyse and PCSO 6505 Clark completed multi agency visits to the caravans around Glastonbury.
- PC 4151 Miller completed an address check in relation to some concerns raised about a male being in possession of prohibited weapons. The address was searched and nothing of concern was found.
- The neighbourhood team have checked a number of addresses in relation to concerns raised by local schools about their students. All students / pupils have been located and welfare checked.

The team have also been helping out in other areas of the force doing scene preservation.

Our team have started to move back into the recently renovated office, which will be fully functioning very shortly. Huge thanks to Glastonbury Town Council for the renovations.
