

PC Moyse Police report to the Town Council – March 2020

This month the Glastonbury Neighbourhood Team have been involved in the following,

- I have continued with the crime reduction visits after the recent increase in burglaries in our area, focusing on vulnerable persons and providing timer switches for lamps. These incidents are continuing to be investigated by our colleagues and some good progress has been made.
- Anti-social behaviour in the town centre has increased slightly. Most of the reports in the last couple of weeks have been linked to an individual who has returned to the area. This is being addressed by the team and the male involved has been moved on a number of times, being given 'words of advice' and with the support of the ASB team I have issued a Community Protection Warning. This male was also arrested over the weekend by our response colleagues.
- There was a criminal damage / graffiti to one of the murals in town. The offender was identified to Police and with the assistance of a Town Councillor in the supply of paint, repaired the damage done. This was dealt with via a Community resolution.
- There were a number of damages to windows and vehicles overnight this weekend in Bove Town, this is in the early stages of being investigated.
- Cuppa with a Copper has continued in cafes around the town centre on a weekly basis. This is advertised in the window of the Beat Office and on PCSO Mel Rowlands facebook page.
- PCSO Mel and I assisted Aster in Evicting persons from one their vacant properties.

We have continued our other work with schools and youths within the community, high visibility patrols in the town centre, attending Neighbour disputes, Domestic incidents and much more.
