Please find below the incidents that the Glastonbury Neighbourhood team have been involved with over the last few weeks.

- Members of the Glastonbury neighbourhood team have been available in café's around the town, to meet with members of the public to discuss any issues or concerns. This will continue every week and locations can be found on the Mendip Police face book page.
- PC Katie Moyse has been working with licensing officers from Mendip District council to start to address the issues around Street trading. We approached a number of persons in the town centre who appeared to trading, educated them with regards to needing authority from Mendip and provided them application forms. Further joint visits are planned to continue this work.
- PCSO Mel ROWLANDS and PCSO Brad HEFFERMAN (our new Glastonbury PCSO!) have worked with the ELIM centre on an outreach day in the town centre. This was to make service users and other members of the public aware of the support available. This will continue on a monthly basis.
- PC Katie MOYSE took part in a multi-agency visit to persons living in vehicles on Bridies mound and the surrounding Beckery area. NHS were the lead agency trying to engage with persons who have been unable to resister with medical facilities and access care and vaccines.
- PCSO Paul LINDSELL and PCSO Brad HEFFERMAN have re-started some of the schools engagement with visits to Tor school.
- PC Katie Moyse arrested a male who was wanted on warrant in the town centre, for failing to attend court.
- PC Karen UPSHALL arrested a male for breaching bail conditions not to attend the town centre of Glastonbury.
- PC Katie Moyse and PC Karen Upshall arrested a female who was wanted on warrant for failing to attend court. This female was then charged with a number of public order offences in Glastonbury.
- PCSO Nik Burge and PCSO Mel Rowlands have been working with the MH team ref concerns for a homeless male in the town centre. This male has now been sectioned.
- PCSO Mel ROWLANDS and PCSO Brad HEFFERMAN have been supporting the enforcement officers from Somerset council in starting the eviction process on Bretenoux road and Stonedown lane, Glastonbury.
