- Multi-agency visits to Bridies Mound with Somerset County Council to prevent the breach of peace in relation to the impending evictions.
- PC Karen UPSHALL and PCSO Mel ROWLANDS managed the Shop Watch Meeting which was hosted on Teams.
- Please note due to operational demand PC Karen UPSHALL and PC Katie MOYSE have also been covering many of the live jobs coming in for response officers.
