

## Monthly Police Report – 11<sup>th</sup> June 2019

A quick insight into the highlights of the Glastonbury beat teams commitments over the last few weeks.

- W/C the 13th May 2019 was County lines focus week. Although we are not aware of any addresses currently being used in Glastonbury, we visited all vulnerable addresses to educate and prevent this occurring in the future. We also supported the neighbouring towns in their visits.
- PCSO Nik BURGE and PCSO Tim RICHARDS (from Street) lead us in a morning of traffic enforcement, which resulted in numerous tickets and a vehicle being seized for no insurance.
- We have worked with Mendip enforcement officers and completed two ASB patrols in the town centre, focusing on persons consuming alcohol in the drinking restriction zone and anti-social behaviour.
- We have attended the Junior section of Tor school and Fairfield Montessori to talk to children about safety, the role of the Police in Glastonbury and Jobs in the Police.
- As you will all be aware it was the funeral of the late John ROPER earlier this month. PCSO Mel ROWLANDS, Insp Mark Nicholson, PCSO Paul LINDSELL and I, were joined by three Special constables for the earlier part of the day. We conducted reassurance patrols in the town centre and assisted with traffic control. PC 2299 Mark Hicks and PCSO Nik BURGE were assisted by support group throughout the afternoon and evening. The feedback from the family, church, funeral directors and public was very positive and this went without a hitch.
- Finally, over the last year the team have been working closely with the Intelligence department to obtain enough information on an address in Glastonbury believed to be involved in the supply of drugs. A warrant was obtained and actioned this week. The result was very positive with two arrested and drugs seized.

Just for the awareness of the council, PS Matt SLADE is still on secondment. His role is now being covered by T/PS 1152 Darren PEARSON. Darren is a very experienced Beat Manager who usually covers Wells city centre.
